 - Kayaking
 - Canoeing
 - Stand-up paddle boarding
 - Sailing, Windsurfing
 - Powerboating
 - Kiteboarding
 - Surfing
 - Yachting
 - Motor-cruising
 - Narrow boating
 - Pulling or rowing
 - White water rafting
 - Traditional rafting
 - Paddle boarding
 - Water-skiing.

Complete 1 session on the water to earn each stage of this badge:

1. Squirrels: Each session should last at least 30 minutes.
2. Beavers: Each session should last about 1 hour.
3. Cubs: Each session should last around 1 to 2 hours.
4. Scouts and explorers: Each session should last around 2 to 3 hours.
