

# Guidance for Young Leaders at 1<sup>st</sup> Locksheath

This document sets out the expectations and requirements for Young Leaders at 1<sup>st</sup> Locksheath Scout Group.

- Before you can volunteer at first Locksheath, you must be fully registered on OSM with the section/s you wish to volunteer with. This means your full details, and those of your emergency contacts.
- Your OSM entry will also be “shared” with our district Young Leadership team, and you must complete training as advised by them.
- If your participation at 1<sup>st</sup> Locksheath is for Duke of Edinburgh’s Award, you must agree goals with your assessor as required by DofE, and work towards them actively.

Attendance is not enough – you must be an active participant in helping our Young People in order to have goals signed off.

- You must attend wearing either the uniform of your organisation (Explorers, Cadets, School etc) or must purchase a 1<sup>st</sup> Locksheath Activity Top.
- Your behaviour must at all times be in line with Scouting Values, and make you a good role model for our young people.
- You should attend for the full duration of each meeting attended, including packing up, unless otherwise negotiated with Section Leaders.
- You must carry and comply with the “Orange Card” at all times.
- If you are unable to attend an evening, you must notify your section leader in advance by email as soon as possible.
- If you are not sure what to do, or how to do it, please ask your section Leaders.
- If you do not meet the requirements set out in this document, you may be asked to stop attending 1<sup>st</sup> Locksheath Scout group.
